	9-5-41		LAC R.E. Holder pilot Anson 6421 on a navigation flight encountered bad weather and made a precautionary landing at Rockey Mountain House, no damage to aircraft or personnel. Anson No. 1832 arrived at this Station for acceptance from Edmonton. Wing Commander W.E. Kennedy assumes temporary command of the Station as of this date during the absence of Wing Commander A.D. Ross, on leave and duty.	
	10-5-41		Wing Commander W.E. Kennedy with Flying Officer J.B. Lawrie flew out to grounded aircraft No. 6421 at Rockey Mountain House to arrange for the Aircraft to return to this Station. Progress examinations being conducted for Course 25 and 27.	
	11-5-41		Flying washed out and the day observed as a holiday. Church parade was held in the morning for No. 1 Duty Watch. The advance party of 35 men of No. 2 Wireless School Flying Squadron arrived at the Station and occupied quarters in the new Barrack Block
