Permit No. 46 - File No. 20119-30.

Confirming our telephone conversation of this day, I hereby make application for an extension in respect to the delays allowed under section 9 of the regulations with respect to the above mentioned permit granted to me on March 17th, 1945.

As explained to you on the telephone, my consulting geologist Russell V. Johnson of Calgary, due to pressure of other work, was greatly delayed in his preliminary examination of the area covered by my permit and his recommendation is that the preliminary geological work should consist of a plane table detailed survey of the surface geology of the area as it applies to the anticlinal fold which occurs in the East part of section 28 and the West part of section 22 and it will require a little time to work out a program in this connection.

In view of the above, I respectfully submit that a delay be granted me for the submitting of a statement containing the detailed information as to the character of the operations to be conducted as well as a delay for the commencement of the actual prospecting operations.
