An immigration policy, directed towards the needs of the country, and not an indiscriminate entry of new comers, was one of the solutions of Canada's economic problems advanced last evening by Prime Minister MacKenzie King at the great Liberal banquet tendered him in the Chateau Frontenac.

With such an immigration policy, he said, the natural resources of the country would be developed, and the cities and towns would not be glutted with unemployed.
