In reply to your letter of the 25th Ultime, enclosing a Resolution of the Chippewas of Walpole Island, locating Samuel Sampson for a pertion of land on the Walpole Island Reserve, I beg to say that as your predecessor was advised, it is not considered advisable to issue Location Tickets for land on this Reserve, until after a sub-division survey has been made.

In regard to desired information as to meaning of the word "occupied", I beg to say that each case should be decided on its merits, care being taken by the Council not to exceed the limit, which it is considered any one occupant is rightfully entitled.
