
Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 17th ultimo and previous correspondence regarding Police Magistrate Wilson's account for services rendered this Department as per voucher No. 3831, I beg to inform you that the account with a copy of the letter above quoted was submitted to the Department of Justice for taxation with the result that the following items, amounting in all to \$13.00, have been disallowed:-

This reduces the account from \$43.25 to \$30.25. With these deductions there are \$4.75 due to the Department which should be remitted.
