

PENALTIES
(Con.)

- (k) Any nation making false charges against any other nation with the object of gaining an unfair advantage or with the intention to injure another nation, shall be declared an aggressor in the first or second degree, according to the seriousness of the case, and upon conviction of such offence against international law, shall be subject to the ostracism penalty for a period of not less than two (2) months, plus debarment from other privileges.
- (l) Any nation or combination of nations found guilty of conspiring in any way to defeat the aims and function of international law as defined by the International Court, shall be declared an aggressor of the first degree and shall also be subject to a minimum penalty of two (2) months ostracism, plus not less than two (2) years suspension from the protection of the International Court, during which period they shall be barred from laying any charges or presenting any cases or complaints whether legitimate or not, before the International Court. They shall also be placed during the period of two (2) years in the category of probationary nations.

REMEMBER!!!

The International Court is not a voluntary organization.
ALL nations MUST be members. No nation can withdraw from membership, thus weakening the organization, and defeating its purpose, as in the case of the League of Nations.
ANY nation withdrawing becomes a world outcast.
