Q. Where?

A. At Forest Lawn.

Q. In what year?

A. 1941.

Q. What type of house did you build?

A. 12 ft. by 24 ft. It had two porches, a back porch and a front porch.

Q. How many rooms?

A. 2 large rooms.

Q. Any plumbing in this house?

A. No, sir.

Q. Any water in it?

A. No, sir. We got the water from neighbours.

Q. What distance did you have to go for it?

A. Just across the back alley.

Q. Approximately 50 yards?

A. Yes, sir.

Q. How long did you and your family live in this house?

A. We only had one boy at that time. We lived there and I had to quit the brass foundry because of my back and illness. I couldn't keep up the payment on the house. I sold the house and paid off the money I owed on it.

Q. How much did you owe on the house?

A. 300 dollars.

Q. How much did the house originally cost you?

A. Originally about 800 dollars.

Q. Did you have much land with it?

A. 4 lots.

Q. So you sold it. How much did you get for it?

A. 700 dollars.

Q. Can you give me the date?

A. In the fall of 1941, just after Christmas. Out of that 700 dollars I paid 300 dollars for the mortgage.
