3. The results of F.C.C.M.'s on the a/n soldiers
are:

Pte. Dornally:

Sentenced to five years penal servitude and to be discharged
with ignominy on 15 APR 48 for:

- (a) Using Govt. vehicle for private purposes.
- (b) Failing to stop when involved in an accident.
- (c) Committing two civil offences (maliciously shooting)
- (d) Using threatening language to a superior officer.
- (e) Resisting an escort.
- (f) Escaping confinement.
- (g) Attempting to escape when in lawful custody.

Earliest possible release 1 SEP 48.

Spr. Monty:

Sentenced to three years penal servitude on 31 AUG 48 for
desertion and obtaining money under false pretences. Committed
on 13 MAR 44 to two years imprisonment. Earliest possible
release 30 DEC 44.

Pte. Lariviere:

Sentenced to three years penal servitude and to be discharged
with ignominy on 23 JAN 48 for A.W.L., stealing articles of
clothing and making away with his clothing. Earliest possible
release 4 FEB 48.
