*Obv.* In field, CHEAP / DRY GOODS / STORE in three curved lines, around the border W. L. WHITE'S—HALIFAX HOUSE HALIFAX.

*Rev.* In field, ONE / FARTHING in two lines, around border PAYABLE AT W. L. WHITE'S—HALIFAX HOUSE HALIFAX N. S. R. 5.

No. 363.

*Obv.* Closely resembles No. 362, but in CHEAP DRY GOODS STORE, the letters are closer together, and the D in DRY is directly under C in CHEAP.

*Rev.* Same as No. 362. R. 9.

I only know of one specimen to be in existence, and it is in the collection of Mr. Thomas Wilson, of Montreal.

No. 364.

*Obv.* Steamboat. HALIFAX STEAMBOAT COMPANY.

*Rev.* FERRY / TOKEN in two lines. R. 2.

No. 365.

*Obv.* ROBERT PURVES—CHEAP / FAMILY / STORE—WALLACE.

*Rev.* In field ENCOURAGE / COUNTRY / IMPORTERS in three lines. R. 2.

This token is evidently a much later issue.
