

hanging horizontal wire is easily adjusted along the top of the fence by means of cross pieces on the posts. This is essential, for foxes are good climbers, and in winter snow often greatly reduces the distance to the top of the fence. The arrangement of subdivisions will necessarily depend somewhat upon circumstances, but the general plan should in most cases conform to that shown in the accompanying diagram. Here a wide outer court is provided, separating the smaller enclosures in which the foxes are actually kept, from the unfenced area.
