eds be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conence sake. For, for this cause pay ye tribute also; they are God's Ministers, attending continually on this very thing. Render therefore to all their s; tribute to whom tribute is due, custom to whom tom, fear to whom fear, honour to whom honour.
