vincial Parliament, to pay over and refund the Amount of the faid Duty, upon Salt imposed by the faid A&, which may have been collected and received by them or either of them, fince the passing of the faid A&, to fach perfors, respectively, who may have paid fach Daty, and in those cases where the faid Duty has been fecured by Bond, Note or other fecurity in writing, it shall and may be lawful for the Officers of His Majelly's Cultoms, and they are hereby required to cancel and deliver up to the respective perfors who may have made, entered into or figned the fame, every fach Bond, Note or other fecurity, which Bonds, Notes and other Securities, and each of them, is and are hereby declared null and void to all intents and purposes.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that if any Salt permitted by this Act to be landed, as aforelaid, duty free, fhall be afterwards put on board any fhip, veffel, boat or other conveyance, and be carried above the aforefaid limits, and there relanded without being field entered at the Cuftom Houfe at Quebec, and the Duty thereon paid or fecured to be paid as directed, in and by the faid Act of the laft Seffion of the Provincial Parliament, the faid Salt fhall be forfeited to His Majefty, his Heirs and Succeffors, and thall be fued for, recovered and the produce thereof divided in the fame manner, as other forfeitures incurred by any Law refpecting the revenue of the Cuftoms, now may be fued for, recovereed and divided, under and by virtue of any Act of the Provincial Parliament.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that hereafter all and every perfon or perfons who may fhip and export Salt from Quebec, to any Port or piace beyond or below the limits herein before mentioned, for the ufe of the aforefaid Fiftheries, fhail be allowed and paid by the Collector of the Cuftoms, out of the Duties which fhall be by him received and collected, under and by virtue of the faid Act of the laft Seffion of the Provincial Parliament, a draw back of eight pence for every minot of Salt which fhall be fo fhipped and exported as aforefaid, provided, the exporters thereof before the payment of fuch draw back do in every referct, feverally comply with, conform to, obferve and execute all and every the terms, conditions, reftrictions and provifions fet forth and contained in the fifth and fixth Sections of an Act of the Provincial Parliament, paffed in the Thirty-fifth year of the Reign of his prefent Majefty, whereby a like draw-back has been allowed and granted.

Persons who have purchased salt, within certain limits, entitled to recover eight Pence per bushel. V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, that all and every Perfon or perfons within that part of this Province, beyond and below the limits herein before mentioned, who, fince the paffing of the faid Act of the laft Selfion of the Provincial Parliament, may have purchafed Salt within the limits aforefaid, fhall be entitled to demand, and, in cafe of refufal, to recover in due courfe of Law, from the perfon or perfons, from whom fuch Salt may have been by him or thein purchafed, eight pence upon every minot of Salt fo purchafed and paid for, and where the faid Salt has not been paid for, then and in that cafe, it fhall and ' may be lawful and the faid Purchafer or Purchafers fhall be entitled to demand and require, and fhall have of and from the perfon or perfons from whom fuch Salt may have
