

Clerks of the Markets, to weigh & measure articles sold in the markets.

To be paid for the same.

Actions instituted under this Act to be tried, &c. in the Quarter Sessions.

Persons exempted from prosecution for any fine imposed, unless the same is commenced within 3 months after the offence committed.

VII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that from and after the passing of this Act, the Clerks of the several Markets in this Province, respectively, shall and are hereby directed to weigh and measure the different articles that are sold and disposed of, in the said Markets, when they shall be thereunto required by the parties interested therein, or either of them, and not otherwise, any law, custom or regulation to the contrary notwithstanding; and they shall be paid for weighing or measuring as aforesaid agreeably to the rates that shall be fixed by the Justices in their Courts of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace.

VIII. And be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all and every action, or suit, that shall or may be instituted under this Act, shall be prosecuted, tried and adjudged in and according to the course of His Majesty's Courts of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, in and for the Districts of Quebec, Montreal, and Three Rivers, as the case may arise therein respectively.

IX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no complaint or prosecution shall be brought against any person or persons for any fine or penalty, by this Act imposed, unless the same shall be commenced within three calendar months after the offence committed.

C A P. VIII.
