## An Ordinance to amend the Law of Partnership.

[10th March, 1869.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Law relating to Partnership;

Preamble.

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Columbia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

I. The "Partnership Act, 1866," of the former Colony of Vancouver Island, Partnership Act, is hereby repealed, provided, however, that such repeal shall not invalidate any 1865, repealed, saving existing rights. acts or things done, or affect any rights acquired thereunder.

II. The advance of money by way of loan to a person engaged or about to Advance of money engage in any trade or undertaking upon a contract in writing with such person on contract to rethat the lender shall receive a rate of interest varying with the profits, or shall receive a share of the profits arising from carrying on such trade or undertaking, shall not of itself constitute the lender a Partner with the person or persons carrying on such trade or undertaking, or render him responsible as such

III. No contract for the remuneration of a servant or agent of any person Remuneration of engaged in any trade or undertaking by a share of the profits of such trade or agents, &c., by share undertaking, shall of itself render such servant or agent responsible as a Partner therein nor give him the rights of Partner. therein, nor give him the rights of Partner.

IV. No person being widow or child of the deceased Partner of a trader, and Certain annuitants receiving by way of annuity a portion of the profits made by such trader in his not to be deemed business, shall, by reason only of such receipt, be deemed to be a Partner of, or partners. to be subject to any liabilities incurred by, such trader.

V. No person receiving, by way of annuity or otherwise, a portion of the profits of any business, in consideration of the sale by him of the good-will of such business, shall, by reason only of such receipt, be deemed to be a Partner of, or be subject to the liabilities of, the person carrying on such business.

VI. In the event of any such trader aforesaid being adjudged a Bankrupt, or In case of bankrupt-taking the benefit of any Act for the relief of Insolvent Debtors, or entering into cy, &c., lender not an arrangement to pay his creditors less than One hundred cents in the dollar, or to rank with other dying in Insolvent circumstances, the lender of any such loan as aforesaid shall not be entitled to recover any portion of his principal or of the profits or interest payable in respect of such loan, nor shall any such vendor of a good-will as aforesaid be entitled to recover any such profits as aforesaid, until the claims of the other creditors of the said trader for valuable consideration in money or money's worth have been satisfied.

VII. In the construction of this Ordinance the word "person" shall include a Interpretation of "person." Partnership firm, a Joint-stock Company, and a Corporation.

VIII. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Partnership Short Title: Ordinance, 1869."
