THE BUDGET SPEECH.

Hon. Mr. Sullivan delivered his budget speech in the House of Assembly last night, a full report of which we hope to publish next week.

Comparing the accounts of this Province with that of Nova Scotia, we find that that Province had only \$1,057,410 to its credit with the Dominion Government.
