WEEKLY MEETING.

The regular weekly meeting of the Municipal Council was held yesterday afternoon. The Mayor and full council were present. After confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting, the following matters were disposed of:

Mr. A. A. Dwyer wrote in reference to road conditions near Windward Lake, and suggested the advisability of having culverts placed in the locality to rectify the same, which would be of great value to the public. The Engineer was instructed to report.

Mr. J. H. Hudson asked that attention be given to the grading of Franklin Street in the opening of this thoroughfare. It was 12 or 18 months ago, the street was properly graded, but lately it has been excavating in places, and the gravel on sidewalks is being given the place by "mud" and irregular appearances. Persons responsible for these conditions are to be notified to have the city cart away immediately.

Mr. D. Hancock wrote asking that the compensation for land on Brine Street, which was reserved for street widening purposes some years ago, be paid to the Council did not expropriate this land, the applicant in lease, the same could not be permitted to hold within 25 feet from the centre of the street, which left the land unproductive. The new street line laid out has not yet been put into effect, owing to lack of finances, but the Council trust that when the loan brought from the Government is forthcoming street improvements such as that above referred to, will be carried out. Mr. C. Crane wrote in regard to the sanitary state of the Southside Rd., which C. F. Forester of the same locality called attention to the necessity of placing a latrine along the wall of the Long Bridge. Both matters will receive attention.

Residents of Stewart Avenue complained of unsanitary condition of same and also of the inadequate lighting. The Sanitary Supervisor was instructed to investigate the matter, while arrangements for better lighting are already under consideration.

Mr. M. Johnson, Chairman of the Memorial Committee, informed the Board that light pillars for use in the Monument are now ready to be placed in position, but it has been found that some difficulty exists as to supplying light in city centre. The communication will be forwarded to the Superintendent of the City Electrical Department, and he will be asked to have arrangements completed.

Application of J. H. Moore to remove his stand at his premises, 25 New Street was referred to the City Engineer.

It was brought to the notice of the Council that a number of persons are driving motor vehicles who are not holders of Licenses. The matter is to be immediately investigated.

The following plans were passed, subject to the approval of the City Engineer—Hudson James, for the erection of a wool-working factory, near Mill Bridge; J. H. Roberts, building, Southside; A. Faulkner, building, LeMarchant Road; Thomas, repairs to Tannery, Redoubt River, which was partially destroyed by fire some months ago.

Mr. J. Hodder must submit proper plan before his application for permission to erect dwelling. Council house can be considered.

Permits for repairs were ordered granted the following: J. G. Collins, Queen's Road; M. J. Summers, repairs and alterations; Water St. Application of Richard Fitzpatrick for permission to build stable, Blackburn Road, was referred to the City Engineer.
