BY-LAW No. — OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EKFRID.

the rate of 4 per centum per annum, that is to say as nearly as may be in equal annual payments, such debentures to be payable at the Canadian Bank of Commerce in the City of London, Ontario, and to have attached to them coupons for the payment of interest.

3rd. That for the purpose of paying the sum of \$3173, being the amount charged against the said lands other than roads belonging to the said Municipality, and to cover interest thereon for 5 years at the rate of 4 per cent. per annum, the following special rates, over and above all other rates, shall be assessed and levied in the same manner and at the same time as taxes are levied upon the undermentioned lots and parts of lots, and the amount of the said special rate and interest assessed as aforesaid against each lot or part of lot respectively shall be divided into 5 equal parts, and one such part shall be assessed and levied as aforesaid in each year for five years after the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said debentures have to run:

4th. For the purpose of paying the sum of \$130, being the total amount assessed as aforesaid against the said roads of the said Municipality, and to cover interest thereon for five years at the rate of 4 per cent. per annum, a special rate in the dollar sufficient to produce the sum of \$29.20 shall, over and above all other rates, be levied in the same manner and at the same time as taxes are levied upon the whole rateable property in the Township of Ekfrid, in each year for the period of five years after the date of the final passing of this By-Law, during which the said debentures have to run. The said amount of \$29.20 to be kept back yearly out of the road appropriation of the Fourth Ward, as originally constituted, till the full amount of \$146 is retained by the Corporation.

Read the first and second time in open Council and provisionally adopted this 15th day of October, A. D. 1887.

NOTICE is hereby given, that any one intending to apply to have such By-Law or any part thereof quashed must not later than ten days after the final passing thereof serve a notice in writing upon the Reeve or other head officer, and upon the Clerk of the Municipality of his intention to make an application for the purpose to the High Court of Justice at Toronto, during the six weeks next ensuing the final passing of the By-Law.

And further notice is hereby given that a Court of Revision will be held in the Town Hall, Appin, in the Township of Ekfrid, on Monday, the 14th day of November, A. D. 1887, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, for the hearing and trial of complaints and appeals made against the above and foregoing assessment or any part thereof, as nearly as may be in the same manner as is provided by chap. 18, 46 Vic., and chap. 180 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario and amending Acts, and all notices of appeal shall be served on the Clerk of the said Municipality of the Township of Ekfrid at least eight days prior to such Court of Revision.
