



FRIED CRACKERS.—Soak square soda crackers well in milk, and fry them quickly a nice brown in a little butter.

GINGER SNAPS.—Two cups of butter, two cups of molasses, two teaspoonfuls of ginger, two teaspoonfuls of saleratus dissolved in one cup of boiling water; knead soft, roll thin, and bake in a quick oven.

CANNED FRUIT.—The fruit put in tin cans should be taken out when the can is opened for use. If allowed to remain after the can is opened, the action of the acid juices upon the tin when exposed to the air may form acetate of tin, which is poisonous. Pour the fruit out into glass or earthen dishes, and the danger of poisoning is avoided. This acetate does not torm while the air is excluded.

GOLDEN PIPPINS.—Boil a quarter of a pound of ginger root, tied in a muslin bar, in a pint of water until the water isstrongly flavoured; add four and a half pounds of white sugar, and boil and skim until clear. Now add three sliced lemons that have been realed and from which the reads have been Now add three sliced lemons that have been peeled, and from which the seeds have been carefully extracted. Add also the thin yellow rind, first parboiled in water. Have ready six pounds of apples pared and quartered, and cook until tender in this syrup, putting in as many at a time as you can tend easily, and lifting them out with a long fork as soon as soft enough to handle. Drop at once in cans, boil the syrup until thick, fill up, and seal.
