Copy of Resolutions passed at meeting of
creditors held at the office of Cronyn & Green-
lees, barristers, City of London, Ont., on Thurs-
day, the 21st August, 1884:

Moved by Mr. Thomas Green, seconded by
T. D. Beddoe:—That the assignee wind up
the company under a committee of three, two
of whom, that is to say G. W. Yarker and
Charles Murray, have been nominated by the
Federal Bank, and the third, that is to say, J.
H. Flock by the outside creditors, with power
of substitution in each case.

The assignee to close up the company as
soon as no orders for work are on hand, and
within 6 months in any event. At the expira-
tion of this six months, or when orders fail, the
assignee to sell the unworked material on hand
and all other property of the company, unless
by that time the company or a new company
make a satisfactory offer of settlement. The
assignee and committee to close up the com-
pany faster if, in their judgment, the result is
not going to benefit the creditors materially.
The assignee and committee to have the power

to buy on credit, incur debts, and to borrow
money to carry on the works, the said borrow-
ings and other liabilities to rank as a prefer-
ence and the assignee and committee are here-
by indemnified against all liability in carrying
out this resolution, and shall have a first lien
on all the assets of the company to indemnify
them against any liability which they or any of
them may incur, but nothing herein is to be
taken to waive any claim which any creditor
may have against the directors or any of
them. Carried.

Moved by G. W. Yarker and seconded by R.
Waddell:—That, notwithstanding the first
resolution, this meeting requests Mr. Muir to
make a cash offer, or its equivalent, to the cre-
ditors within 60 days, and, when prepared to do so,
to call the creditors together for the purpose of
considering such offer. Carried.
