Economic co-operation

As a trading power, Canada has particular interest in the growth and stability of the world economy. The increasing interdependence of national economies has shown itself in a series of "economic summits" bringing together the leaders of the seven main industrialized democratic countries, including Canada. The efforts of these leaders to define the specific problems of the world economy, and their commitment to co-operate wholeheartedly in solving these problems, complement the ongoing efforts of the international forums.
