AmbuTech is a manufacturer and marketer of canes and mobility products. Founded in 1982, the company was acquired by Melet Plastics Incorporated in 1990, and operates as a fully integrated division of Melet. Melet is an ISO certified company and has approximately 35 employees.

The AmbuTech line of support canes was originally based on a patented design that incorporates a threaded bottom section. This allows the cane to be adjusted over a full 20 cm. range, so that the height of the cane can be set to the exact requirement of the user, and this feature makes the AmbuTech cane unique to any other support cane. AmbuTech expanded the concept of an adjustable cane for orthopaedic use into a support cane for the visually impaired.

In addition, AmbuTech manufactures and markets folding mobility canes and identification canes for the visually impaired. Customers for the line of mobility products for the visually impaired include the Canadian National Institute for the Blind, the United States Veterans Administration, the Helen Keller National Center, and the Braille Institute.

The AmbuTech line of orthopaedic canes and mobility products for the visually impaired is also sold in selected countries around the world. The company expects to increase international sales substantially in the near future by expanding the number of warehousing distributors that carry the line.
