severely penalized for having done so, and I will demand of the minister a complete explanation for this injustice.

I state most emphatically that the whole question of severance pay and vacation pay should be referred to the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration for reconsideration of this most despicable section of the new Unemployment Insurance Act.
