

Mr. Borden laid before the House, Report of the Canadian Delegates to the International Conference, held at New York for the consideration of the Commemoration of the First Century of Peace between the United States and the British Empire.

Mr. Borden moved,—That the House do go into Committee of the Whole forthwith to consider the Classification and Organization of the Staff of the House of Commons, submitted to the House by His Honour the Speaker on the 3rd June, instant; which was agreed to.

The House accordingly went into Committee of the Whole.

(In the Committee.)

The following Resolutions were adopted:—

1. Resolved, That the Classification and Organization of the Staff of the House of Commons, adopted by Resolution of the House on the 10th May, 1909, be cancelled, and the Classification and Organization as set forth below be substituted therefor, to take effect as on 1st July, 1913.

2. Resolved, That in the case of new appointments to vacancies in the First Division the new appointee shall enter the service in the grade below that of his predecessor, but this regulation shall not apply in the case of promotions of officials in the Service of the House.
