CAP. LXIV.

Preamble,

- I. Board of Water Commissioners constituted.
- II. Their duties.
- III. Power to employ Engineers, Surveyors, &c.
- IV. Power to enter upon lands, within 20 miles of Hamilton, and to appropriate as much as may be required, and to divert water-springs, making compensation therefor. Provisions for arbitration in case of disagreement as to amount of compensation.
- V. Lands and Water so appropriated to be vested in the Corporation of Hamilton, with power to construct reservoirs and water-works thereon. Power to lay down pipes through intermediate lands, and through streets, roads, &c. No house, garden or orchard, to be taken without consent of owner.
- VI. Punishment of persons maliciously hindering the operations of the Company.
- VII. Materials procured under contract with the Commissioners to be exempt from execution. Commissioners to pay the moneys due for the same to the judgment creditor.
- VIII. Commissioners and their clerks to be sworn: to keep books of their accounts, and records of their proceedings—to be examined by Lee Clause the Corporation. Semi-annual Reports to be made to the Cor-
 - IX. Commissioners to regulate the distribution and price of the water.

 The hydrants, &c., for the extinguishment of fires, to be under the control of the Corporation.
