any account or book or document of the Association, except as authorized by the Council or by the Association in General Meeting.

- 25. At the Annual Meeting of the Association the Council shall lay before the Association a Balance Sheet for the period since the preceding account was made and up to within thirty days of the Meeting where such Balance Sheet is presented, or (in the case of the first account) since the Incorporation of the Association. The Balance Sheet shall be accompanied by a report of the Council as to the state of the Association affairs and the amount which it recommends that shall be the Annual Fee of the Association for the following year.
 - 26. A copy of the Balance Sheet and Report shall be sent prior to the General Meeting of the Association, together with the notice calling for such General Meeting to all members of the Association, in the manner in which notices are to be given hereunder.

NOTICES

- 27. A notice may be given by the Association to any member either personally, or by sending it by post to him to his registered address as recorded in the Register of the Association, or to the address (if any) supplied by him to the Association for the giving of notices to him.
- 28. When the notice is sent by post, service of the notice shall be deemed to be effected by properly addressing, prepaying and posting a letter containing the notice, and unless the contrary is proved to have been effected at the time at which the letter would be delivered in the ordinary course of post.
