THEIR Terms of Sale vary according to circumstances—the principal object being to secure an industrious and thrifty class of Settlers.

A small payment at the time of sale is usually demanded to insure that the application is made in good faith; and time is given for the payment of the balance of the purchase-money.

The price of Land varies from Ten Shillings to Twenty Shillings per acre, but the average price of good Farming Land is about Twelve Shillings and Sixpence per acre.

Improved Farms, with Buildings complete, may be purchased in any part of the Eastern Townships, at from £200 to £750 for a lot of 200 acres.

Town Lots, in Sherbrooke Town, for trade or manufacturing purposes, may be obtained at from £30 to £50 per quarter-acre building lots, or rented, with water-power for manufacturing purposes.
