THEIR Terms of Sale vary according to circumstances—the principal object being to secure an industrious and thrifty class of Settlers.

A small payment at the time of sale is usually demanded to insure that the application is made in good faith; and time is given for the payment of the balance of the purchase-money.

The price of Land varies from **Ten Shillings to Twenty Shillings** per acre, but the average price of good Farming Land is about **Twelve Shillings and Sixpence** per acre.

**Improved Farms**, with Buildings complete, may be purchased in any part of the EASTERN TOWNSHIPS, at from **£200 to £750** for a lot of **200** acres.

**Town Lots**, in **SHERBROOKE TOWN**, for trade or manufacturing purposes, may be obtained at from **£30 to £50** per quarter-acre building lots, or rented, with water-power for manufacturing purposes.
