## FRESH ADVANCE IN CORN PRICES

**Prospect of Enlarged European Demand Has Effect Upon Market.**

Chicago, Nov. 29.—Broad humanitarianism reported as the probable basis of food shortage relief in Europe, had much to do today with stimulating bullish sentiment in the corn market. Prices closed strong, 2c to 3c net higher, with December 13 1/2 to 1 1/2, and January 13 1/2 to 1 1/2. Oats gained 1 1/2 to 2 1/2. In provisions, the outcome ranged from five cents decline to 1 1/2 advance.

Altho announcement that one of the biggest distilleries in the country would close down tonight led to much selling at times in the corn market, the general movement of prices was clearly upward. Scantiness of offer together with other tokens that farmers were refusing to sell freely at current values, but that a few at a disadvantage and the trade was in a ready mood to place full stress on the fact that the situation in Europe would be alleviated if a situation was possible and that help would not be confined to the United States, but would have wide scope wherever great finish was at tip-top prices of the corn. Oats ascended with corn and with the aid of a fair demand from local buyers. Provisions averaged lower owing to weakness in the hog market.

**MONTREAL PRODUCE MARKET.**  
 Montreal, Nov. 29.—There were no further developments in the condition of the local market for produce, prices being unchanged at the recent decline noted owing to the fact that there was no improvement in the local market from any source, and business was dull with cash sales at 2 Canadian western oats quoted at 95c; No. 3, 97c; No. 4, extra No. 1, 1 feed at 93c; No. 1 feed at 91c; white at 91c and 90c per bushel, ex-store.

A letter from business was done in small lots of flour today for shipment to outside points, and this coupled with the steady demand from local buyers, straight cars and smaller quantities, created a better feeling in the market, but there was no change in prices to note.

A good, steady trade continues to be done in all lines of produce, and the market is fairly active and well supplied. There was no further development in the condition of the market for produce today.

A very firm feeling continues to prevail in the egg market, and prices for all grades are fully maintaining.

A good, steady trade continues to be done in potatoes in a jobbing way, and the market was active with no change in prices to note.

There is a tendency to strength in the butter market, and, altho no actual change in prices was announced today, the prospects are that they will be marked up next week.

The market for small Quebec cheese was easier, with sales for domestic account at 26c to 28c per pound.
