Most of the Despatches from That There is No News.

THE FAKIRS APPEAR TO BE EXHAUSTED

One Despatch is That Dewey is Practically Governor of the Philippines, and Another is That He is "Sewed Up" and Unable to Send News Home—Rumors in London That the Queen Regent and the Boy King Have Left Madrid—War Reports That Amount to Nothing.

WAR EPIGRAMS.

A despatch from Singapore to a Boston man says Commodore Dewey is not executing the duties of Governor-General at Manila. A strong anti-English feeling is said to be developing in Cuba. The storm of civil war is fast approaching in Spain. All reports of an understanding between the United Kingdom and America are positively pronounced absolutely groundless. Riot still rages in Spain. The mob are shouting "Give us Weyler or Don Carlos." Martial law has been proclaimed in Cartagena, but the authorities cannot enforce it. Big French liner Lafayette captured off Havana Thursday night by the U. S. warship Annapolis, aided by the Wilmington, Newport and Morrill. There was an exciting chase. The Lafayette is a French naval reserve vessel and the capture may have to be explained to France. Spanish authorities are circulating a report that Dewey has been entrapped at Manila and cannot send out news as to his doings. Spanish torpedo boat Tamarico sailed from Buenos Ayres, going northward. Two little Spanish fishing schooners were captured and taken to Key West. Firing heard off Charleston, but no vessels sighted. The Pope is said to have telegraphed the Queen Regent of Spain advising her to sue for mediation of the powers. Hong Kong advices received at Madrid say the Americans are reported to have landed at Cavite after a fresh bombardment.

HAS THE QUEEN SKIPPED?

Persistent Rumors That Her Majesty Has Gone With the Boy King.

New York, May 6.—(Special to The Toronto World.)—A London special says: There are persistent rumors here that the Queen-Regent and King have left Madrid secretly for the frontier, their destination being Vienna. No verification is obtainable. A Washington special says: A Cabinet officer says to The Journal correspondent that Porto Rico will be taken by Monday and General Wesley Merritt will be the first military governor.

Roosevelt's Rough Riders.

A Washington special says: The great numbers of men applying for enrollment in Roosevelt's rough riders caused him to say today: "If I were allowed to take all who apply, I think I could rid Cuba of Spaniards without further aid."

Cause of the Release.

A Key West special says: The French steamer Lafayette was released because the State Department promised the French Foreign Office, before the vessel sailed from Coruna, to allow her to enter Havana and deliver despatches to the French Consul-General. The naval authorities were not notified of the fact. Part of her cargo was consigned to Havana, but no contraband goods were found.

More's Great Speech.

The Minister of the Colonies Spanish Great Enthusiasm in the Spanish Cortes. Madrid, May 6.—In the Senate today Senator Pulgarer refused an explanation of the war in the interests of the Government.

NEWSPAPER MAN SHOT.

Mr. Halstead of the London Graphic and New York Herald Executed in Porto Rico as a Spy. New York, May 6.—(Special to Toronto World.)—The Journal says Halstead, the correspondent of the London Graphic and New York Herald, has been shot at San Juan, Porto Rico, as a spy. He was arrested several weeks ago for taking photographs of the fortifications.

THE ROOM IN WREATH.

On the appreciation of the last three days in the price of May wheat Letter is understood to have cleared up of \$1,000,000 to \$1,800,000. His sales on Thursday reached a total of 2,500,000 bushels, and his profit is easily figured out at the above amount when it is remembered that he bought much of the cereal around \$20. Two weeks ago it was estimated that he had made \$5,000,000 out of his deal in May wheat so that he is now close on to \$7,500,000. This young prince of speculators is now making heavy purchases of the July article, and there are those who think that he will be able to control the price as successfully as he has this month's.

Salisbury's Words Resented.

London, May 7.—The Madrid correspondent of The Times says: "Although Lord Salisbury's words on the Hispano-American situation before the Primrose League are greatly resented here by moderate and far-seeing men, it is rather than advice to fight, given in a bitter and unpalatable way, and to seek to minimize the inevitable consequences of the situation. 'Nobody has yet ventured publicly to advocate the doctrine that in the unequal combat Spain is only called upon to fight, and that the tendency of thought is in that direction makes for peace.'"

France Doesn't Like It.

London, May 7.—The Paris correspondent of The Daily Telegraph says: "The effect upon Paris of the seizure of the steamer Lafayette is clear enough. Already a bitter feeling against the United States had existed and this incident will certainly tend to intensify it. If it is demonstrated eventually that there was nothing to justify the seizure, the Government may be expected to make the very strongest protest. Some angry expressions are to be heard, and arrangements have been made with the prefect of police for the strictest protection of the United States Embassy. The place is well guarded by policemen, and detouring by militia. Ontario wheat would be higher but for the fact that, partly because of the war and of the heavier freight movement over Canadian roads, transportation charges have materially risen. It may be stated in conclusion that the quantity of Canadian wheat marketed and ground since last harvest is estimated by a local grain dealer to be five times that of the ordinary year."
