In presenting a summary of the work for the past year, your Committee would note with gratitude the increased liberality on the part of the Congregation in the all-important work of aiding in the extension of God's Kingdom upon the earth.

From an examination of the Treasurer's statement it will be seen that there has been a good increase in both Sabbath Collections and Contributions through the hands of the Missionary Collectors, the total amount in excess of last year being \$677.34.
