

Silver Plating.
Silver plating can be accomplished, according to a new German process, by dissolving freshly precipitated chloride of silver in a solution of hypochlorite of soda (11 parts to 10 parts of water), adding 0.180 part of sal ammoniac to this solution and stirring in eight hundred parts of fine washed chalk. This mixture is rubbed on the article to be silver plated until it dries and a bright deposit of pure silver will be obtained.




