MAY.—Caterpillars have been always a great source of annoyance and cause of loss. That coal oil will cause instant death to these pests has been proved beyond all doubt. A correspondent of the "Leader" says he experimented with the oil, and was perfectly satisfied. He applied the oil with a brush made of feathers, placing a small quantity on the nests. He says, "instant death ensued." The proprietor of the Leader made the experiment at Glengrove Farm, Yonge Street, and says, "In a couple of hours one quart of oil had cleared the orchard completely of caterpillars."
