

cant lot cultivation, but something has been doing also in the west, according to a statement recently made by Frederick Abraham, honorary chairman of the vacant lots and home gardening section of the Canada Food Board. Millions of dollars, he says, will be added this year to the wealth of the dominion by this movement.

"Production has certainly been on a much larger scale in the dominion than ever before, due mainly to the splendid activities of vacant lot and home gardening organizations. To be able to state that is very gratifying to myself and every member of the Canada Food Board. But the food, and more still, will be needed, even if the war were to end tomorrow.

"You can gain some idea of how the vacant lot movement has taken hold when I tell you that in Winnipeg alone no less than 21,000 vacant lots are under in cultivation there are also in the do-minion large numbers of back lots and land owned by large companies in culti-vation, which have remained idle up to this year, or at the best were used mere-ly to grow flowers."
