

Evidence for Prosecution
on Fourth Charge.

First Witness: L-12471- Sgt Harvey, A.M. SSK, ^{CASF}
~~for Prosecution~~ being duly called and sworn, is examined
 by Prosecutor and states:-

I held the rank of Private Sgt. I was called to the Guard Room on March 12/40 at 11:20 hrs. Because the accused refused to get out of bed, make up his bed and clean out his cell room. A few minutes later I saw R.S.M. Straman, of the SSK, who instructed me to give Pte Hill, the accused, the order to make up his bed and clean up his cell, and I was to give him 10 minutes to do so. This I did, having 2 witnesses with me at that time. The accused, Pte Hill, refused to get out of bed and said at that time that he was going to do no more work in this army. He continued to lie in bed. While he was lying in bed he was smoking a cigarette. I informed him at that time that he would be charged with disobeying an order. I called in Pte Macdulaney, Pte. to search this man. Pte Macdulaney was a G.M.P. and was on hand, that's why I called him. Pte. Macdulaney then went over to accused Hill's bed and pulled the blanket off him. The accused Hill, jumped up and said "There isn't no one in this army can search me." and the accused started fighting with Pte Macdulaney, right then. The accused states
