After paying net revenue charges there was a surplus of £154,283, Adding the balance of £2,545 the total was £196,835. Out of this sum the directors recommended the payment of the half-year's dividend on the 4 per cent, guaranteed stock, amounting to £85,520, leaving a balance of £7,013 to carry forward.
