Record Figures for Winter Port Traffic

Gain in Cargo Valuations of \$1,072,947 Over Last Season's Freight Business--Canadian Goods Showed Decline of \$2,000,000--Grain Exports Good--Remarkable Gain in Passenger Travel.

With the filing of the South Africa steamship Kwara's outward manifest at the custom house yesterday, the winter port business was brought to a close for the season of 1910-11.
Although there were 112 sailings from this port showing a gain over last season of \$1,072,947, the winter just passed has been the banner one in the history of the winter port. The valuation of United States products, such as meats, lard, etc., is greater than ever before, showing a valuation of over \$8,000,000.
