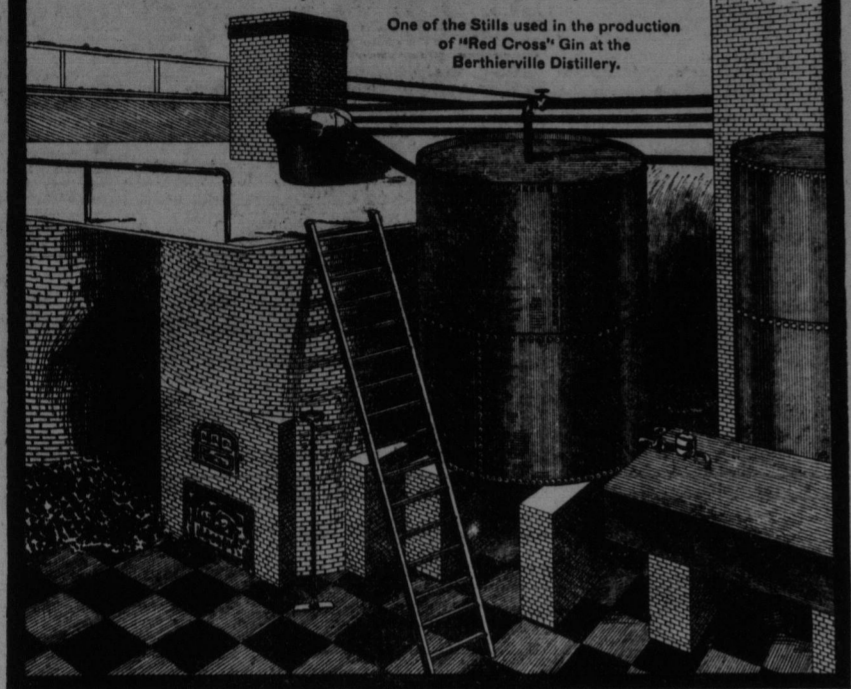

DRUG COMPANY PLANS TWO LARGE BUILDINGS

Will Sell Present Property on Wellington Street West.

Toronto, April 26.—The National Drug and Chemical Company of Canada has decided to erect at the corner of Beverley and Phoebe streets two five or six-story reinforced concrete buildings to cost in the neighborhood of \$200,000. They will sell their present property at 27.29 Wellington street west, near Bay street, the brick and stone building on which was erected four years ago a five storey structure, it has a frontage of 60 feet on Wellington and a flankage of 170 feet, and is valued, roughly, at \$115,000.

The company's new plant will be the most modern in America. Before approving of the plans members of the firm will visit Seattle, Portland, Los Angeles and St. Louis, where most up-to-date drug manufacturing plants and warehouses are to be found.

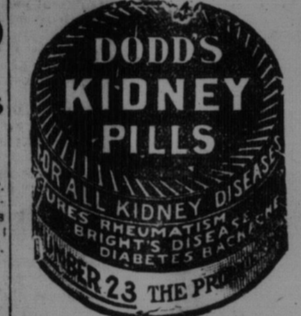

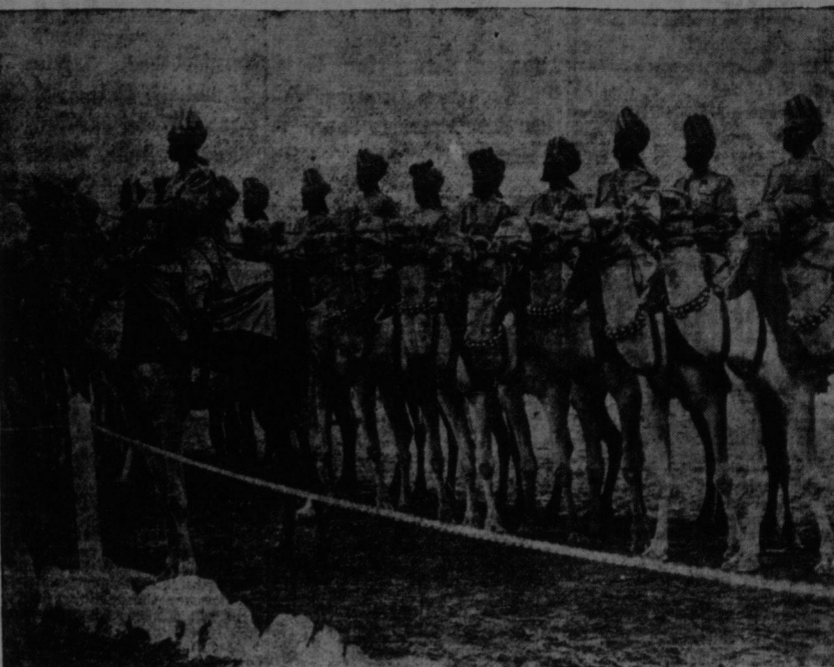

With King George Through India



DURBAR IN KINEMA COLOR

Although from the point of view of pageantry the Durbar at Delhi will remain the dominant feature of the royal visit to India, from the spectacular point of view the King's visit to Calcutta was even more important. In Delhi the King was surrounded by soldiers and officials, by native princes and European visitors; in Calcutta he was in the heart of a great native population that had promised a royal welcome on the occasion of the visit of the King and Queen and the reception and "Elephant Parade" was the most extraordinary spectacle of the "Durbar."

It consisted of a series of processions by native retainers wearing the armour and costumes of earlier ages. There were elephants without number, painted in elaborate and grotesque designs, and decorated with gorgeous embroideries. There were camels and camel carts, dancing horses, bullocks, sacred ox, tigers, crocodiles and the barbaric war dance of the Palks the hereditary retainers used as palace guards throughout the Orissa states, formed in two troops, with pink and blue turbans, painted chests and legs, and silver swords and shields; they danced a mock combat with rapid writhing motions and sudden leaps. Color succeeded color in endless combinations and forms, jeweled litters, glittering emblems, a vast herd of gigantic pachyderms, the howdahs of massive gold, richly upholstered within, the animals completely decked with jewels, the tusks are of gold, and the elephants wear a frontlet of gold chain mail, a gold

chain around the neck, ornaments of gold work covers their ears, and golden anklets adorn their feet. The kinema exhibition shows every detail and affords a striking example of the perfection to which this branch of the photographic art has been brought and it is safe to say without fear of contradiction, that the series, coming to the Opera House for one week commencing next Monday evening, April 23, with daily matinees thereafter, of the "Durbar" is the most pretentious offering in the entire history of the moving picture world.

The value of the pictures will be further enhanced by the lecture of Sidney Hollingsworth, who comes here direct from the Garden Theatre, New York. During the run of the pictures here the prices will range from 15 to 50 cents with seats now selling.
