

1936, he was transferred to "E" Division where he was stationed at Esquimalt until 1944, when he was posted to Victoria. Hope was discharged to pension July 11, 1946.

Reg. No. C/641, C/M Pui-Kau Hi, 44, died May 16, 1978, at Montreal, Quebec, of cancer. He was born October 24, 1933, at Hong Kong, and joined the RCMP on May 8, 1969, at Montreal. He served continuously in "C" Division until his death.

Reg. No. 16378, ex-Cpl. Alexander Duncan, 74, died November 5, 1978, at Vernon, B.C. He was born at Huntly, Scotland, on November 11, 1903, and served with the Moose Jaw City Police from 1927 until 1937, before joining the British Columbia Provincial Police on June 6, 1938. He engaged in the RCMP when the BCPP was absorbed on August 15, 1950. During his nine years with the Force he served at Vernon Detachment and Fairmont. He retired to pension on November 11, 1959.

Supt. Lawrence Maide Lapointe (Rtd.), 68, died December 29, 1977, at Calgary, Alta. He was born August 15, 1909, at Tupper Lake, New York,

USA, and joined the Force July 19, 1927, as Reg. No. 10339, at Ottawa, Ontario. He was sent to Depot Division for recruit training, following which he was posted to Regina as a detective constable serving the Southern Saskatchewan district. He was discharged April 4, 1931, and joined the Alberta Provincial Police on April 9, 1931, and re-joined the Force on April 1, 1932, when the APP was absorbed. He was posted to "K" Division where he served at Edmonton, Lamonte and Balton. He was promoted to corporal April 1, 1941, and sergeant April 1, 1943, when he was transferred to Yorkton. In 1945, Lapointe was transferred to Swift Current, Sask., and on March 1, 1946, was commissioned Sub-Inspector. He was appointed personnel officer for "A", "G", "N" and "O" Divisions, and in 1947, for "D" Division. In 1948 he was promoted Inspector and transferred to "G" Division where he became O.C. Fort Smith Sub-Division. In 1951, he was transferred to "F" Division as O.C. Regina Sub-Division, and in 1956, he moved to H.Q. Ottawa where he became Senior Training Officer. Lapointe was promoted Superintendent October 2, 1957, and on October 1959, he was invalided to pension.

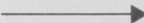
