AFTER REPARATION, CENTRAL POWERS TO BE ADMITTED.
PARIS, Feb. 8, (By Fred S. Ferguson)—The initial governing body of the League of Nations will be an executive committee of seven, one representative for each of the five great powers and two for the smaller countries it was learned from a reliable source today.

This agreement is said to have been contained in one of the twenty-two articles of the constitution, half of which are officially announced as having been accepted by the special committee on the league of nations. It would indicate that the minor powers lost their contention for larger representation on the executive committee.
