CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

OF THE

THIRD BATTALION

Mictoria Rifles of Canada

Organized 22nd January, 1862.

Special designation "The Victoria Volunteer Rifles of Montreal conferred by Sign Manual 18th July, 1862.

Designation changed to "Victoria Rifles of Canada," and authorized to bear the words "Eccles Hill," in recognition of services rendered by the Corps in that engagement,

Mil. Gen. Orders 5th December, 1879.

Revised and adopted at a Special General Meeting of the Corps held on the 7th day of November, A.D. 1878.

I.—Officers.

The Officers, other than the Staff, (who shall be appointed by the Officer Commanding,) shall be elected by the votes of the majority of the Elective Committee, subject to the approval of the Officer commanding and the Officer commanding the Militia of the Dominion of Canada, but if it should appear to the Officer commanding the Corps that its interests would be advanced by appointing to the vacancy a gentleman not then a member of the Battalion,
