Has been Deputy Reeve of Vaughan. Is a Provisional Director of the Huron and Ontario Ship Canal Co. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. Pop. 11,458. M. in 1862, Mary Matilda, dau. of Robert Gibbons, Esq. Admitted as an Attorney, U. C., May, 1862. Is Captain of Huron Rifle Co., and a Councillor of Goderich, which last position he has held for several years. First returned to Parliament at last g. e. Pop. 22,075. No. of voters, 5,178.—*Goderich, Ont.*
