An Act to legalize the By-law No. 18 of the Village of Ingersoll for raising a certain sum of money therein mentioned.

W HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the legality of the By-law Preamble. number eighteen of the municipal council of the village of Ingersoll, authorizing the issue of Debentures to the amount of Six thousand eight hundred pounds, for the purposes therein mentioned: 5 And whereas Debentures have been issued under the said By-law, and the said municipality hath petitioned to have such doubts removed and the said By-law declared valid: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts and declares as follows:
