Appearance of
a Quorum. That upon the appearance of a QUORUM, the Speaker shall take the Chair, and the Members be called to order.

5.

Black Rod. That the Speaker shall always take the Chair when the Black Rod is at the door, whatever the number of Members then present may be.

Order and de-
corum. That the Speaker shall preserve Order and Decorum, and shall decide Questions of Order, subject to an appeal to the House.

7.

Speaker,
when to vote. That the Speaker shall not take part in any Debate or vote in any case, unless the House shall be equally divided.—He may give his reasons for so voting. He shall stand uncovered when addressing the House.
