

Such animal or animals to the pound keeper, or to notify said pound keeper of the fact of such animal or animals being there, in which last case, it shall be the duty of such pound keeper to go after such animal or animals and impound the same, for which the party taking ^{said} animal or animals, shall be entitled to the sum of twenty five cents per mile, one way only, for each such animal so taken.

7th If any such person or pound keeper subjects or refuses to comply with the provisions of the foregoing clause ten days after such animal appears on his premises or that he has been notified of the same, such person or pound keeper shall incur a fine of \$5.00 & costs for each animal recognizable before the Indian agent, half the fine to go to the informer.

8th That the pound keeper's fees be as follows -

For each stallion, bull, or boar over two years of age impounded 50^{cts} per day, under two years of age 25^{cts} per day. For each & every, mule, horse, mare, ram, pig, cow or ox 20^{cts} per day. For every sheep ten cents per day, for each & every other horned animal under two years old 15^{ccts} per day, the pound keeper in every case to give a receipt for animals delivered to him, & for the monies received by him.

9th For the purposes of this regulation, each & every pound keeper shall have the power to auction impounded animals.
