There was also a slight misunderstanding over the figures on the pay envelopes, due to the fact that increase slips did not get through in time to be included in the pay in the regular way, and the amount of the increase was put in afterwards. All this was explained to the satisfaction of the men.

On Feb. 28th, conference was held between the Management, Conciliator Benjamin, and the Conference Committee of the General Works Committee. Exhibit "A" gives details of the decision arrived at.

On March 1, 1918, the employees of M-14 accepted the settlement proposed.

Exhibit "B" shows the case up to the time the men returned to work, as submitted by Mr. Moore of the General Works Committee.
