

The Municipal Act of Ontario gives full power to every Township to pass Bylaws authorizing Railways to be carried along existing Highways, and the several Railway Acts of Canada and Ontario provide that no Railway shall be carried along an existing Highway unless leave has been obtained from the proper municipal or local authority therefor.

The By laws in question are returned herewith.
