aware, and I fear very much that his inspection of the schools would be not at all no thorough no that of Do Milly who appears to be a shoroughly, competent officer and accustomed to the work of school unspections I have written to the authorities of the merhodist Church remening the application of the Board and the recoinmendation of this Dept. that the schools of that Church on the Six Nation Reserve should be placed under the administration of the School Board and that then resident Museronary should become a representative on the Board.
