- 2. That your request to be furnished with the names of the tenderers and amounts tendered cannot be complied with.
- 3. As to bogus tenders, the Department had previously to the receipt of your letter instructed the Indian Agent to report upon each tender, &c.
- 4. Your wish to amend your tender for part of Lot No.27 cannot be acceded to.
