

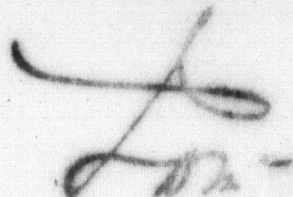

Sir,-

In view of the report contained in your letter of the 28th ultimo, I beg to say that an order for three hundred vaccine points has been sent to the Montreal Vaccine Institute for you in order that you may vaccinate the Indians in your District. The Department desires that you will kindly vaccinate all the Indians who will submit to the operation. You will be allowed twenty-five cents for each vaccination and also your actual travelling expenses. Kindly report later stating whether the vaccine reached you in good condition and also the number of Indians vaccinated.
