Ottawa, July 31, 1918.

Sir:-

Referring to your telegram of the 29th instant, asking for information as to the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 28, Tp. 32, Rge. 2, W. 2 M., Key Reserve, I beg to state that the following night letter was sent you as relating to the principal and interest past due on this property, being the third to the 8th instalment, inclusive, and interest at 7% on the purchase money and on overdue interest.

"Amount due on northwest quarter section twenty-eight thirty-two two west of second, principal four hundred and thirty-two dollars with interest two hundred and sixty-six dollars seventy cents. Order in Council enacts that interest be charged at seven per cent on all arrears. Am writing."

I may say that the ninth and tenth instalments, not being yet due, may be paid with interest at 5%, provided such payment is made on or before the respective due dates of these instalments, in accordance with the terms of sale.
